## Region 9 Delegate Meeting Minutes

Region 9 AHA  
Delegates Meeting-Ft. Worth, Texas  
June 18, 2011

1. Call to Order-Pat Barton was done at 11:02 am.
2. Officers and Delegate Roll Call was officiated by Jane Ann Godsey. A quorum was established.
3. Meeting Agenda. A change to the meeting agenda was motioned by Carla Jo and seconded by Margo. The agenda change was approved.
4. Recessed to Youth Foundation at 11:15 am. Motion to call to order done by Cindy Savage. Report done by Cindy Savage, and seconded by Carla and Carolyn. Approved by delegates. Report by Sandy Bentley to motion to approve \$14,400 this year for Alexa Nichols and Rachel Cinotto for scholarships. Thank you was delivered to stallion service program, box seat programs.
5. The youth foundation has several downloadable forms that include trade schools and junior schools. The Youth Foundation meeting adjourned at 11:21 am
6. Youth foundation Adjourned
7. Reconvening of and call to order for region 9 Meeting was done by Pat Barton.
8. Approval of January 22, 2011 Delegates meeting minutes. Charles Bass recommended that the portion of the minutes pertaining to the Youth Foundation be removed from the minutes of the Region 9 delegates meeting as they are covered in the minutes of the Youth Foundation. Karlan made the motion to accept the minutes as revised, Karen Meites seconded, and the minutes were approved.
9. Treasurer's report. The treasurer's report was presented by Cindy Savage. See attached. It was noted that the Youth Fund was approximately \$8400.00.

Charles Bass moved to approve budget, Mark Himmel seconded, and the report was approved.

10. Budget revisited.

- a. Financial audit. Larry Leahy noted the treasurer used generally accepted accounting procedures. Some recommendations were made to the board.
- b. Newsletter expense adjustment. An amendment was made to line item #8. Charles Bass made the proposal from the financial planning committee to amend line #8 to \$3650, which will be a bottom line savings of \$2650.00. Karlan seconded, and motion was approved.
- c. Sponsorship. After discussion, Charles Bass made the motion to sponsor a \$300.00 Youth Nationals jacket, Karlan seconded, and the motion was approved.

1. Election of Region 9 BOD Officers. Ballots were handed out, and nominations were taken from the floor.

- a. Charles presented the nominations for Director: Karlan made the motion that the nominations cease, and this was seconded by Beth Walker. The new Director will be Margo Shallcross.
- b. Nomination for Vice-Director. Mark Himmel was nominated for Vice-Director in addition to the listed nominee. Mark Himmel was elected Vice-Director.
- c. Secretary. Karlan moved the nominations cease, Carla Jo Bass seconded, and the winner was Jane Ann Godsey.
- d. Treasurer. Charles moved the treasurer Cindy Savage be elected by acclamation. Seconded by Karlan and approved by delegates.
- e. Arkansas State Representative. With no further nominations, Charles moved, and Karlan seconded to elect Jeremy Harper by acclamation.
- f. Louisiana State Representative. There were two nominations, and Debbie Himmel was the winner of the Louisiana State Rep.
- g. Oklahoma State Rep. With no further nominations, Charles recommended the nominations cease, and Herb Meites was elected
- h. Texas State Representative. Carla Jo Bass moved the nominations cease, and Karlan seconded, and Carrie Woolverton was elected Texas State Rep.

1. Guest Speaker was Stan Morey, the AHA Judges & Stewards Commissioner.

Stan noted the next judging seminar would be December 1-2, 2011 at the Scottsdale Millennium show. He explained what his office does, and that he is accessible via phone (303) 883-2612. There was also discussion of points of emphasis with regards to halter, and also noted the videos that are available.

1. Region 9 Championship Show Report was presented by Kristen Fisher. At closing date, there were 450 horses, however, there ended up being a total of 504 horses. Last year saw 533 horses. There were several larger classes and the AATR classes were great. The weather had made things challenging. The dirt in the arena was too dry at the start of the show, but was better towards the end of the show. The exhibitor's party was planned for 400 people but had about 280 to come. The analysis of shavings would have cost the Region approximately \$6000.00 additional. Working western events were down.
2. Sport Horse Regionals. Bill Eash reported the show would be in Waco on July 14-17th. There were still 4 more pages available in the program, and sponsorships were still welcomed.
3. Results of contested elections-already noted.
4. Committee reports.

- a. Youth Committee-Monies received for youth shirt sponsorships. Youth delegates discussed. Also there was discussion about the golf cart decorations (yellow submarine theme) at Youth Nationals.
- b. Texas Horseman's Legislation-Carrie Woolverton noted the bill did not pass, and everyone needs to keep in touch with their legislator.
- c. High Point Awards-Jane Ann Godsey noted there was participation, and the forms still need to be retyped.
- d. Horseman's Awards-Pat noted that Betty Bechtold would be in charge of receiving nominations.

1. Unfinished business.
2. New Business.

- a. Cowgirl Hall of Fame Inductee Luncheon-this will be held October 26th, 2011. It is during US Nationals. Debbie Cinotto will set up and Jane Ann Godsey will help with ideas.
- b. AHA Strategic Planning questionnaire-Dale Harvill discussed the questionnaire.
- c. Any other new business.
  1. September Meeting. Discussion among the members that they would like the meeting during the State Fair Show. Jane Ann will find a room for the meeting.
  1. Dates reminder. Pat reminded the delegates that the meeting at Convention did not yet have a location, but that would be communicated to delegates.
  2. Directory. The directory would be published, and the cost would be about \$4000.00.

It would be published using data from August 1.

## Fire Strikes Goslin Farm

Tuesday, August 9, 2011 the Arabian Community was visited by another cataclysmic nightmare when a barn fire struck the Fred Goslin/Gwen Nix farm in Magnolia, Texas. The blaze erupted at 6 a.m. in the training barn housing 28 show horses. 14 horses were lost in the fire, but 14 were rescued by Fred and Jennifer and their children Casey and Crizta. The barn housed nationally decorated horses for people throughout the Southwest area, including several of the family's children's horses.
