## AHA Region 9 Sport Horse Championship Show

The Region 9 Sport Horse Championship Show Committee met in August last year for a wrap up of the 2005 show and assigned sub committee chairs for the 2006 show. We met again at HorseFest in Mesquite in January and finalized plans for enhancements to the Region 9 2006 Championship Show which will be held in Waco, Texas, July 15-16.

Steve Montgomery graciously offered to sponsor a Region 9 Sport Horse Championship banner to be used as a backdrop for photographs.

New classes added are Training Level JTR, Arabian Hunter Hack and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Hunter Hack.

To encourage Sport Horse breeding we have added four classes for two-year-olds and under in a new jackpot in-hand competition. Eighty percent of the entry fee will be paid back to the first five places. The winner of each of the four classes will receive a cooler and ribbons to the top five places. The classes are Arabian Fillies two and under, Arabian Colts and Geldings two and under, Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Fillies two and under and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Colts and Geldings two and under. These horses will be shown on the triangle. There are no class qualifications for these classes and we encourage you all to bring out your young horses that may be

Sport Horse prospects and see how they stack up against their peers. Note this is not a "Regional Championship Class" and the bronze trophy will not be awarded.

Sandi Chohany will be the Dressage and Sport Horse Judge this year and Dr. Karlan Downing will be judging the Hunter Hack classes. We will have our annual silent auction again on Saturday night during our progressive barn party. We want to encourage our exhibitors to participate in the party since it is a time for them to show off their horses and have one on one time to discuss breeding and training possibilities with potential clients.
